4) Financial Highlights and Review

Paul provided a short presentation and review of the unaudited accounts made up to Dec 31st, 2022. The details of the presentation were made available to members and volunteers prior to the meeting. No issues were raised. It was noted that the current balance was in excess of £12k.

The charity expects to hold around £10k ringfenced in case of unplanned crises that may severely reduce or curtail BuzzWorks revenues for a prolonged period.

5) Re-election of Trustees

Giorgio Martinelli and Mari Stevenson stood down as Trustees as required by the constitution. Mari who stood for re-election was duly voted in as a trustee to serve again in 2023.

6) Area Updates

Each area representative provided a two-minute synopsis of their respective areas. Details of each area update were circulated to members and volunteers prior to the meeting. The relevant documents are available on request.

Janet Southwood announced that she was standing down from gardening due to other commitments. She kindly offered to help with the handover. Janet was thanked by all for the endless hours put into getting the BW site developed to its present state over the years.
